

Student Service's Information about Registration

Welcome to Langley High School's information about registration for the school year 2010-2011. Our faculty and staff are proud to offer excellence in our curriculum designed to provide thought-provoking and challenging courses which will prepare students for their future after graduation. The Langley Course Catalog is available on the Langley website and the core courses are outlined along with the electives and diploma types.

The academic course selection is one of the most important choices a student makes during his/her time at Langley. Students should plan carefully with their parents and put thought into their choice of courses for next year. Teachers, counselors, and administrators will be helping your child make selections that are in line with graduation requirements and future academic endeavors or/and future employment. Teachers will be providing the counselors with recommendations about their current students and counselors will begin meeting with the students. We are providing the following dates to help you and your child make informed, intelligent decisions concerning your child's schedule for next year. As in the past, students taking AP courses and Academy courses must complete additional paperwork to be enrolled in these courses and must have approval from their parents (these contracts can be found on Blackboard and can be picked up by your student from their counselor). After the students discuss class selection with their counselor, this information will be sent home for the parent/guardian to sign.

- The signed course selection sheet is due back to the Counseling Office by **March 26**.
- Changes can be made up until **March 26** through the student's counselor with parent permission. **After this date, a Course Selection Change Form will need to be filled out. Because of constraints in the FCPS budget, we may or may not be able to offer the change depending on the availability of the space in the course. A waiting list will be established when a class is full. We appreciate your patience and understanding.**

Dates: Discussion of the Registration Process:

- **On January 11 and 12, the counselors will split the sophomore students into groups during Saxon Time.**
- **On January 14 and 15, the counselors will split the junior students into groups during Saxon Time.**
- **On January 21 and 22, the counselors will split the freshman students into groups during Saxon Time.**

Dates: Registration Process:

- **On February 1-19, the counselors will meet with the rising seniors.**
- **On February 22-March 5, the counselors will meet with the rising juniors.**

- On March 8-19, the counselors will meet with the rising sophomores.
